

# Introduction

Congratulations on your purchase of your Spyscope. This stylish scope is crafted from durable brass with a base stand constructed of wood and brass. The scope is rugged enough to use, yet elegant enough to display on your mantel. This Luxurious piece will be the center of talk for hours to come.

## **Using Your Telescope**

#### WARNING: VIEWING THE SUN CAN CAUSE PERMANENT EYE DAMAGE. DO NOT VIEW THE SUN WITH THIS SCOPE

- 1.After you have removed the scope and the base stand from the box, seperate it from the base by pulling it up, causing it to pop out. (see figure 1 below)
- 2.Now that the scope and the base have been separated, pull the Barlow all the way, extending it to its full capacity.
- 3.Point the objective lens to the object and look through from the eyepiece. slightly push the Barlow in to focus, continue until you see object at its clearist. Sometimes it is necessary to pull a bit outward again, if you pushed the Barlow in to much. By pushing or pulling the Barlow little by little the image will come into focus gradually

# **Using Your Telescope Cont.**

4.By turning the Barlow, while pulling it in/out, it will help you make micro adjustments, so that the scope will not slide in or out erratically (see figure 2 below)

### **Taking Care Of Your Spyscope**

- 1. When wiping the lenses, use the cloth that comes provided with the Spyscope if there is no available cloth provided use a soft, lint free cloth.
- 2.To remove any remaining dirt or smudges, add one or two drops of Isopropyl Alcohol to the cloth
- 3. When not in use always remember to store your Spyscope in a dry, moisture free environment.
  - IMPORTANT: It is very important that you never attempt to clean your Spyscope internally or even try to take it apart


